



## Town of Amherstburg COUNCIL BRIEF

At the Town of Amherstburg Council meeting held on February 21, 2012, Council:

- Received a delegation from Jennifer MacLellan regarding Nutrition. Council proclaimed the month of March 2012 as Nutrition Month in Amherstburg.
- Received a report regarding Extension of Contract for Joe Levack, Acting CAO and directed that Administration begin an internal and external search for the position of Acting CAO.
- Approved a report from Dean Collver regarding the Amherstburg Farmers Market (AFM) Pilot Project and closure of Ramsay Street and the Municipal Parking Lot (M-7) at the corner of Richmond Street and Ramsay Street on June 10, 2012 and July 8, 2012.
- Passed By-law 2012-11 being a By-law to designate the property at 51 North Street and known as the Clement Parlette House as being of architectural and cultural heritage value and interest.
- Awarded a contract to the lowest bidder, being SLR Contracting Group Inc., for the Malden Centre Drain Project.
- Awarded a contract to the lowest bidder, being Rivard Excavating Ltd., for the Shuell Creek Drain Project.
- Adopted the 2012 General Rated Budget of \$22,702,834 resulting in a tax rate increase.
- Approved a donation of \$70.00 to the 9-1-1 Advisory Board.
- Directed Administration to bring back a report on the legal process in preparation to repeal the current Heritage Rebate By-law 2006-18 and that Administration seek input from the Manager of Acquisitions and the Ministry of Tourism and Culture.
- Passed By-law 2012-15 being a By-law to authorize the execution of an agreement with Amherstburg Professional Firefighters Association.
